

Countries connected to their primary trading partner in 1990











a. US-China tariff rates toward each other and rest of world (ROW)






b. Percent of US-China trade subject to tariffs





- Chinese tariffs on US exports - US tariffs on Chinese exports · · · Chinese tariffs on ROW exports · · · US tariffs on ROW exports




- Objectives (among others) announced during the presidential campaign:

Note: Trade refers to average of exports and imports. Figures for 2025 and 2026 are projections.


